

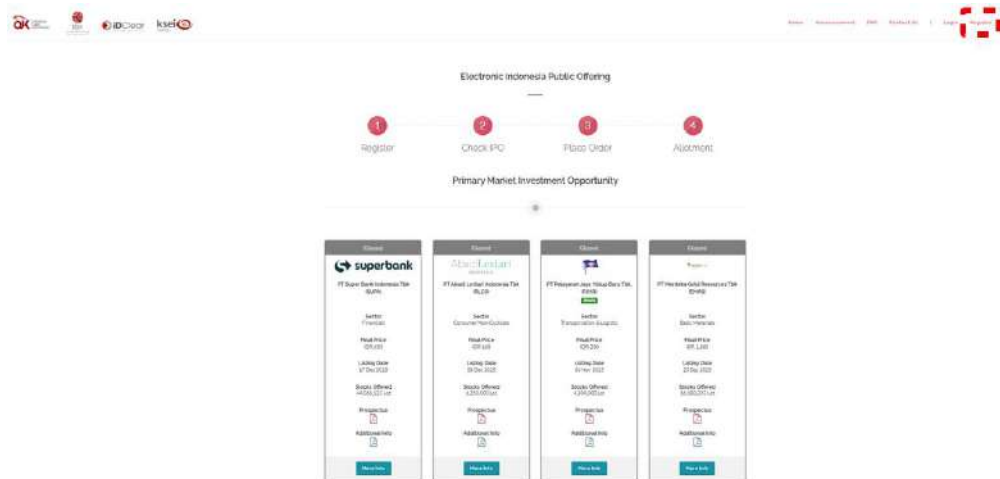
Two-Factor Authentication (2FA) Setup Guide

To enhance e-IPO account security, Indonesia Stock Exchange (IDX) has implemented a Two-Factor Authentication (2FA) feature during account registration and login (for users who are newly registered, registered but not yet activated 2FA, and those who already have 2FA) on the system. Below is the 2FA setup guide for the following processes:


1. **Account Registration**
2. **Login to e-IPO System**
3. **2FA Reset**
4. **What should be done if there is an issue during the 2FA setup process?**

1. Account Registration


- 1.1. Go to the webpage: <https://e-ipo.co.id>
- 1.2. Investors who wish to submit indications of interest and/or orders directly but do not yet have an account on our system may register via the **Register** menu



- 1.3. Enter your email address and select the account type (Individual or Institution), then click **Send**



1.4. Complete the investor information accurately, then click **Send**.

- 1.10. Download an authenticator application on your Android/iOS device (e.g., Google Authenticator, Microsoft Authenticator, Authy, or other authenticator apps). Open the application and scan the QR code displayed on the screen or manually input the code provided. Then enter the 6-digit code generated by the authenticator app and click **Verify & Enable 2FA**.



- 1.11. The e-IPO homepage will appear, and the investor has successfully logged into the e-IPO system.

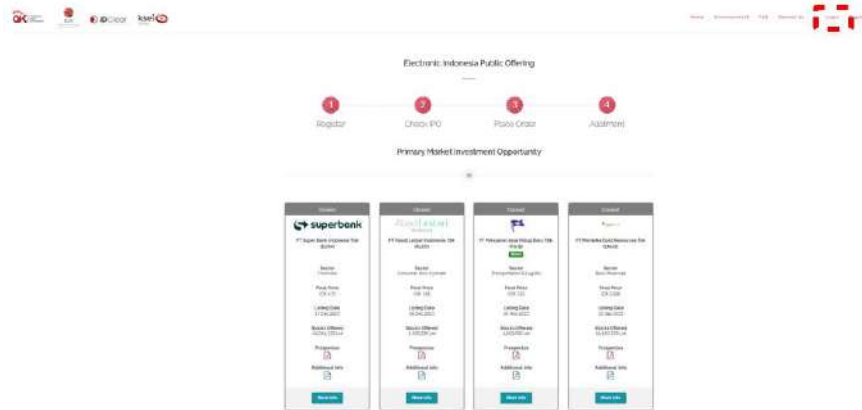


2. Login to e-IPO System


2.1. Account Already Registered but 2FA Not Yet Activated

- 2.1.1. After the Securities Company/System Participant has verified your account registration (the Securities Company/System Participant has the right to reject registration if there are data discrepancies), Investor may log in and submit indications of interest and/or orders via the e-IPO System.

- 2.1.2. Go to the webpage: <https://e-ipo.co.id>, then click **Login** (please ensure you use lowercase letters for your email address when logging in or using “Forgot Password”).



- 2.1.3. Enter your email address and password, then click **Login**.

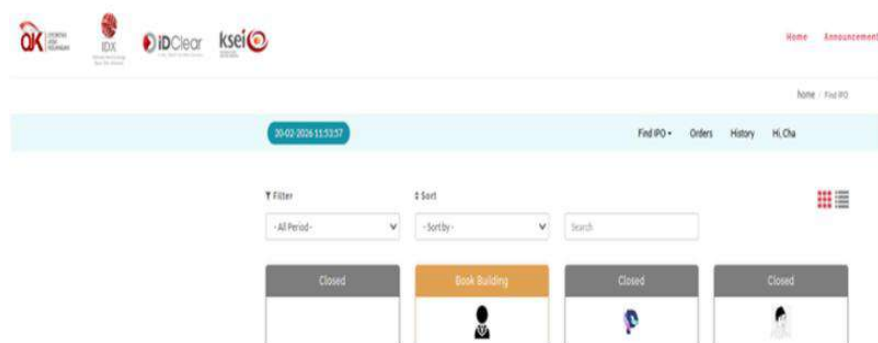

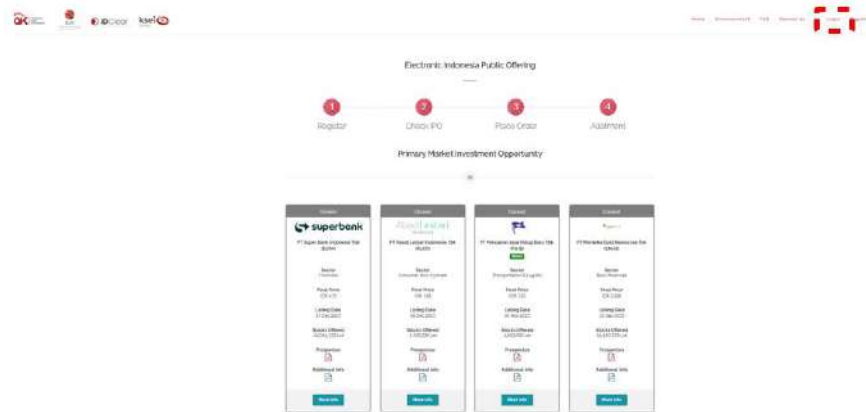
- 2.1.6. The e-IPO homepage will appear, and you have successfully logged into the system.




2.2. Account Already Registered and 2FA Activated

- 2.2.1. After the Securities Company/System Participant has verified your account registration (the Securities Company/System Participant has the right to reject registration if there are data discrepancies), Investor may log in and submit indications of interest and/or orders via the e-IPO System.

- 2.2.2. Go to the webpage: <https://e-ipo.co.id>, then click **Login** (please ensure you use lowercase letters for your email address when logging in or using “Forgot Password”).




- 2.2.3. Enter your email address and password, then click **Login**.



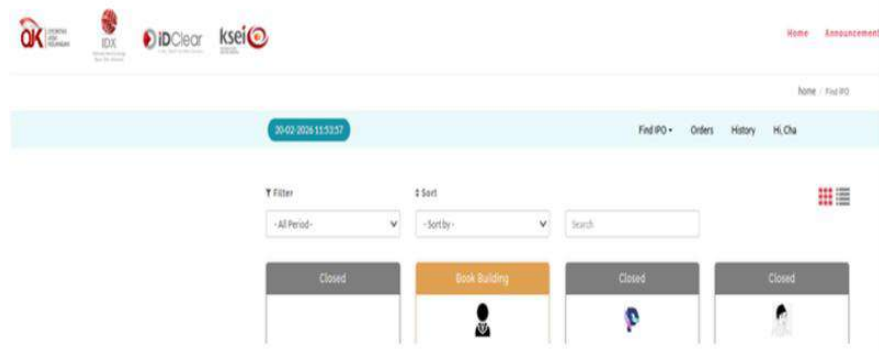

- 2.2.4. Open your authenticator application and enter the 6-digit code displayed, then click **Verify**.



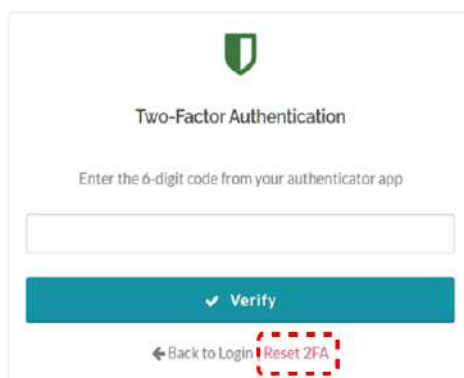

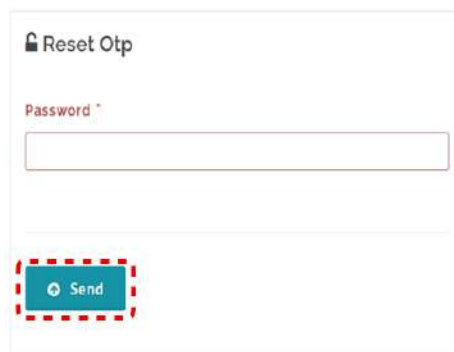


3. Reset 2FA

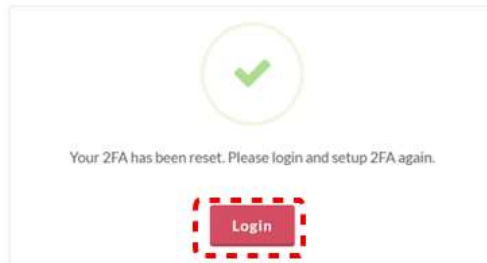
- 3.1. If an investor wishes to change the registered mobile number, after successfully logging in, click **Reset 2FA**.



- 3.2. The investor may then proceed with the 2FA reset via the OTP reset link sent to the registered email. Enter your password and click **Send**.



- 3.3. The 2FA reset has been successfully completed. Please log in again and reconfigure 2FA following the steps under Section 2.1 (**account already registered but 2FA not yet activated**) above.



4. What should be done if there is an issue during the 2FA setup process?

Referring to the provisions of Article 21 of Financial Services Authority Regulation of The Republic of Indonesia (POJK) Number 41/POJK.04/2020 concerning the Implementation of Electronic Public Offering of Equity Securities, Debt Securities, and/or Sukuk, as follows:

1. In each Public Offering of Securities, each investor may only submit 1 (one) interest and/or order through each System Participant for allocation in Pooling Allotment.
2. The interest in the Securities to be offered and/or order for the offered Securities through the Electronic Public Offering System is obligated to be submitted:
 - a. directly through the Electronic Public Offering System;
 - b. through a Securities Company that is a System Participant, where the investor becomes the customer; and/or
 - c. through a Securities Company that is not a System Participant, where the investor becomes the customer.

Accordingly, with reference to clauses 2.b. and 2.c. above, **if the investor encounters an issue during the 2FA setup process, the investor may submit an order through the Securities Company used by the investor**, either via the sales representative or through the Securities Company's Online Trading System that facilitates e-IPO subscription orders for its clients. **Investors are advised to contact their respective Securities Company for further information.**
